For sound system
2. United Yorkie Rescue – 1 line/plug, 110v/15amp
For a computer and display screen
3. Humane USA, Senator Afflerbach – 1 line/plug, 110v/15 amp
For a laptop computer
4. CPAA Mobile Van – 1 line/plug, 110v/20 amp
For lights, small refrigerator, air conditioning

SOUTH STREET/FRONT STREET ELECTRIC BOX

1. Mike's Hard Ice Cream – 1 line/plug, 110v/20 amp
For freezer and milkshake maker
2. Bricker's French Fries – 1 line/plug, 110v/20amp
For fryer, lights, drink machine
3. Wilson's Funnel Cakes – 2 lines/plugs, 110v/20 amp
For freezer, exhaust fan, hot water heater, lights, air conditioning
4. Rock-It Pizza – 1 line/plug, 110v/20 amp
For refrigerator, pizza oven, lights
5. CPAA Hippy Hound Café – 1 line/plug, 110v/15 amp
For two crock pots, 2 tabletop grills, small refrigerator

PINE STREET/FRONT STREET ELECTRIC BOX

1. Acoustic Band Area – 2 lines/plugs, 110v/20 amp
For sound system
2. Hairy Hound Dog Training – 1 line/plug, 120 v/15 amp
For Computer and display screen
3. Air Expressions – 1 line/plug, 110v/15 amp
For heat press, laptop computer, printer
